14th December 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Social Distancing not feasible.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Masks worn on entry and when moving around. Removal of masks for singing is personal choice (this applies to audience and members).• Hand sanitiser stations remain in place.• Members to bring their own equipment (music, pencils, drink etc).• The church is responsible for cleaning the venue before and after use.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Members/audience to be prepared to layer clothing.• Space well ventilated; doors and windows open.• Sit/stand side by side.• Singers to be at least 2m from MD and Accompanist.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Do not arrive before 6.45 pm (Stage Crew - 6.30 pm).• Hand sanitiser available for use.• Members to meet in the church hall. Coats to be left in the church hall.• Audience/Members to be seated as soon as possible on arrival.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Risk assessment available for all members.• Simple instructions/expected behaviours sent to members.• Verbal reminders at concert.

Guidance for members/audience:

Before the concert	
	<p>Do not come to the concert if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You have symptoms / feel unwell • You have tested positive (PCR or Lateral flow) • You have been told to self-isolate • You are quarantining after a visit abroad. <p>If you have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid, we require you to take a lateral flow test on the day of the concert. (We can provide you with a test kit if you haven't got one).</p> <p>The church will be cleaned before and after the last use</p>
During the concert	
	<p>Be respectful of each other's space</p> <p>We will keep doors and windows open for as long as possible - consider bringing warm clothing</p> <p>Wash / sanitise your hands on arrival</p> <p>Follow any protocols the church has in place</p> <p>Avoid touching shared surfaces as much as possible</p> <p>Bring your own music, pencil etc. Do not share equipment if possible (use hand sanitiser if you have to)</p> <p>Bring your own refreshments – there will be no interval. Please ensure that you take all your belongings, including water bottles with you, when you leave.</p>
Notes:	<p>Even if you have been vaccinated you must apply by these rules</p> <p>If you wish to discuss any of the above, please contact any member of the committee.</p>

Stage Crew to arrive at 6.30pm to put out chairs/prepare for arrival of audience/members.

Members to arrive at 6.45 pm. Stage Crew to remain at the end to put chairs away.
